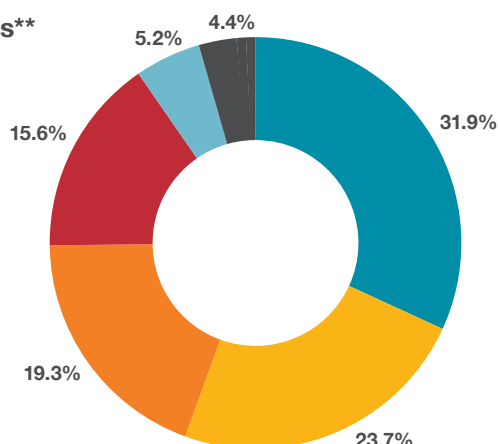
Each semester, many ANU College students successfully graduate their pathway course and begin the next exciting chapter in their education journey.
